AHAI News and Notes:

- State Tournament info packets should have been received by now, if any information is incorrect contact Jim Powers or Mike Mullaly. Brackets should be published by January 30. Combined teams are required to play in the state tournament, to be excused from play contact the High School committee.
- Varsity white division restrictions have relaxed some and combined teams may apply to play in this division. Application must be made to the High School Committee. There will be a limited number of spaces available for combined teams.
- All Clubs should encourage their coaches to vote for All State and Showcase players.
- Submit Coach of the Year nominations to Jim Powers or Mike Mullaly as soon as possible.
- State tournament elimination games may begin February 1 and must be completed by February 26. Home teams should set up game date with opponent and schedule referees. Any team experiencing scheduling issues that cannot be resolved should contact the High School committee.
- To be eligible for State Tournament players must have played at least 75% of eligible games. Games not played due to injury count towards this 75%. Clubs should have documentation to support the games not played due to injury in case they are contested.
- AHAI Center games begin February 29.

Suburban Business:

- All Star games were well attended and it appeared that there was great Club member attendance. Pictures of the teams and award presentation were sent to the AHAI for inclusion in their newsletter and posted on Facebook.
- Clubs are encouraged to send Senior Night pictures to AHAI for publication on Facebook. Also, any team that is planning a Senior Night event should advise their opponent and the officials of such.
- All Teams should make every effort to not have to reschedule games. If rescheduling is necessary be sure to keep in mind how difficult it will be to find available dates as the season draws to a close. If anyone has a problem rescheduling, contact Ron for assistance.
- The February meeting will be a mandatory play off scheduling meeting for all Clubs. The meeting date has been moved to February 11. Playoff opening weekend will begin February 19.
- Play off divisions, at this time, will be JV three divisions, Varsity two divisions.
- Clubs are asked to look at game schedule on AHAI. Any game that does not show stats indicates a missing score sheet. Contact Dave Zednik or Ron if you have any questions.
