2018 Playoff Overtime Procedures

First round, Quarter Finals, and Semi-Final Rounds

- 1) A “Four on Four” 5 minute stop time Sudden Death period. Teams will be required to switch ends similar to the 2nd period format. Goaltenders will defend the goal furthest away from their bench.
- 2) A “Best of Three” person Shoot Out. (see format rules below)
- 3) Sudden Death Shootout

Goaltenders will defend goal on team bench side. For all Shootouts **Home** team has choice to shoot first or defer to the **AWAY** team. If “Sudden Death” shootout takes place all eligible skaters (no goalies) must shoot before repeating any player. Any skater serving a **minor** penalty that did not elapse during play may take part in the shoot-out. **No player serving** a 10 minute misconduct that did not expire during the overtime may take part in shootout.

All Division Championship Finals (Best of 3)

If score tied at the end of regulation play the game goes to a “Sudden Death” overtime format. **NO SHOOTOUTS !**

Full 16-minute periods for Varsity and 15-minute periods for Junior Varsity will be used and game is to be played until a winner is determined. Teams will switch ends for each and every overtime period played.

Any / all penalties that occur in regulation time will carry over into the overtime.

For Varsity games it is suggested that the ice be resurfaced after 2 periods of overtime are played. (this is suggested but optional based on rink management)

For JV games it is suggested that the ice be resurfaced after no later than after the first overtime period. (this is suggested but optional based on rink management)
