### **AHAI News and Notes:**

- High school clubs' Presidents meeting to be held at AHAI Center September 17, 2014.
- AHAI College Night October 13, 2014, to be held at Woodfield Hyatt in Schaumburg. The format of the event has changed and proves to be more pertinent and interesting. Anyone interested in playing hockey after high school must, at some point, attend. You must register to attend this event.
- USA Hockey level 4 coach clinic September 27 and 28.
- AHAI is again offering free baseline testing for the Step aHead concussion monitoring program. All clubs are encouraged to participate.

### **Suburban Business:**

- A brief review was done of current division rule changes including the Board's decision to limit number of varsity players that can play down at any one time would be 2 players.
- Roster issues were discussed. Each club must forward roster link (from Laura) to Ron before first game. All Indiana teams must also submit their rosters to Dave Zednik by September 20 so he can manually input them into the system.
- The game scheduling for Saturday, September 20 was briefly discussed. Retiering, if necessary, will take place about half way through season when balance of games are scheduled.
- League fees for this season were announced, \$3400 for Varsity, \$2900 for JV. There was no increase in fees this year due to the fact that the division wanted to expend some of the current funds they have on hand. Clubs were reminded that they needed to submit \$250 deposit per team before the season started and that half of the league fees are due prior to each team's first game.
- Hold Harmless agreements and Code of Conducts for each club are required by the division.
- Everyone was reminded of the new playing rule changes.
- Peter gave treasurer's report. Division continues to be in good financial shape.

### **Old/New Business**

Club, coaches and manager contacts can be found on the division website.

Clubs were reminded not to use clear labels for scoresheet player lists and to not include players that are eligible to play up or down on those list. They should only be written in when they will actually take the ice.
